#### Preventing disease

We get diseases from tiny organisms called germs. These can be viruses, bacteria or fungi. These tiny organisms enter our body through openings such as the nose, the mouth, ears, anus and genitals. They can also get into our body by our skin through cuts and bites. Germs can spread from one person to another through the air, for example when people sneeze, cough or shout. If you are also infected and you do these actions, the contaminated air or spittle touches the next person and they get infected. Bad air from a sick person equally makes many people catch illnesses. Some organisms also attach themselves to surfaces, so if we touch that surface, we will pick up that disease as well. The best way to prevent these diseases is to practice good hygiene. Simple measures, like washing hands thoroughly with soap and clean water can make a huge difference, as this helps to wash off or kill the germs before they get a chance to enter the body.

Good hygiene should also be respected when preparing and preserving water and food. Contaminated water is a common source of getting dangerous germs. Water that is collected from wells and other doubtful sources such as rain water, streams, rivers and lakes should be treated before it is consumed.
